## Who can take part?

- Your child will soon be starting school and has not previously attended a daycare centre.
- The “Step by Step” programme is also suitable for your child if they have been identified as needing support following the language assessment (Delfin 4).



## Dear parents,

Soon your child will be in school!

This will be a big change for the whole family, but especially for your daughter or son.

To make the start easier for you and your child, you can make use of the “Step by Step” programme. On various mornings, you exchange ideas with each other and trained parent guides. They can support you through their own experiences with topics such as everyday school life, learning conditions and the German education system. Due to their own being from immigrant backgrounds themselves, the parent guides speak different languages. In addition, there is always the possibility of calling in language mediators if communication is not possible.

In the next room, your children can play, sing and do handicrafts with their peers and learning companions. Along the way, the children gain important language experience, which is necessary as preparation for the upcoming start of school.

Please feel free to come along with your child!

## Eligibility requirements

All children must provide proof of measles protection in accordance with the Infection Protection Act.

If your child is not vaccinated, make an appointment with your paediatrician. Vaccination is mandatory for participation in the programme. Please inform the doctor’s practice of this when making your appointment.

**Please provide proof of two vaccinations.**
